



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **AGE:** A player is deemed eligible if they have not turned 19 by 17 March 2019.
2. **PAYMENT:** Players will not be permitted to play until their entry fee is paid. They must also be a registered junior with WA Squash.
3. **PLAYING TIMES:** all players must be available to play from 12noon Saturday and 9.00am Sunday and at any other time specified during the tournament. First round times will be available from The Squash Factory and WA Squash on Friday 15th March. It is the player's responsibility to establish the time and date of their first and subsequent matches.
4. **THE DRAW:** Divisions will be decided by level of ability. Draws will be seeded by the Tournament Director.
5. **BALLS:** Dunlop Yellow Dot Balls will be used for all Divisions (where applicable).
6. **SCORING:** All matches in the individual event shall consist of best of 5 games PAR11 scoring. Players are guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches in the individual event. Matches in the Doubles will be time based.
7. **PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR:** All players must wear protective eyewear that complies with Squash Australia policy whilst on court irrespective of whether they are competing in a match or just practising. Non-compliance with this may result in the player being defaulted from the tournament.
8. **REFEREEING:** Players are required to mark/referee the match before or after their match as directed by the Tournament Director or Tournament Referee.
9. **PRESENTATIONS:** All players receiving prizes/trophies shall attend the presentation ceremony. Any player not attending must make collection arrangements with the tournament organisers or may forfeit their award.
10. **WITHDRAWALS:** Any player who has entered this tournament who then withdraws after the draw has been completed will still be liable for full tournament fees.
11. The tournament organiser, WA Squash and its officers, employees or agents shall not be liable for any death or personal injury or loss or damage to property sustained or incurred by any person in connection with the tournament howsoever caused.
12. The Tournament Director reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry, disqualify any player for late arrival or misconduct, combine events, alter match times, and vary conditions of play.

DOUBLES COMPETITION RULES

1. **Teams will be determined by the Tournament Director and will be based on joint rankings.**
2. **The draw will be completed on Saturday after confirmation of all entries.**
3. **Scoring will be PAR timed squash.**
4. **Matches will be played Saturday afternoon ONLY after the completion on the scheduled individual matches.**
5. **Depending on entries, the event will be knockout/round robin.**

Players entering the tournament agree to:

- Refrain from any conduct which would bring the sport into disrepute
- Abide by the Regulations and Policies of Squash Australia
- Comply with the reasonable directions of tournament officials
- No alcohol is to be consumed by any junior

- Irrespective of age, no player is to consume any prohibited drugs. Any player found to be under the influence of any prohibited drug during the course of the tournament will be in breach of these conditions.
- Participate in any random drug testing conducted by the appropriate authority
- The player is to be registered and an insured member with their Club/State or country of origin
- Eyewear is compulsory for all juniors.

In signing this form I agree to comply with the Tournament conditions as set out in this entry form. By signing this entry form I/we accept the conditions of entry as outlined above. I/we acknowledge that any breach of these conditions will render me/my child liable for suspension for the remainder of the tournament and banned from attending any premises associated with the tournament. I/we understand the Tournament Organising Committee will decide on any suspension in relation to the WA Squash tournament conditions. Any appeal against a decision of the tournament Organising Committee will be referred to the General Manger of WA Squash. I/we understand WA Squash may invite the Club/State/Territory Association of any suspended palyer to consider any further sanctions against an offending player. I/we understand the Tournametrn Entry Fees will not be refunded to any suspended player.

I/we give permission to WA Squash and the Tournament Organisers to use any photographic image taken of me at this event to be used in printed publications on the internet or in other electronic formats.
